Snow & Ice Management Tips



SHOVEL EARLY AND OFTEN



SELECT THE CORRECT PRODUCT

Salt only works when pavement temperature is above 15°F. (use a temperature gun to check). In colder temperatures, use different products.



SCATTER SALT SPARINGLY

Space salt granules 2 to 3 inches apart.



SWEEP UP & RE-USE EXCESS SALT



HIRE CERTIFIED APPLICATORS
