


# Lake Riley Herbicide Treatment

## May 2023

RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. See map below for treatment areas.



**RPBCWD** will work with a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control Curlyleaf Pondweed in the lake. *The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.*

**What:** Herbicide treatment (Diquat)

**Where:** Within designated area(s) on lake (*see map on front*)

**Why:** To control Curlyleaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant

**When:** **Week of May 15<sup>th</sup>**, if weather allows. Delays/rescheduling will be posted online at [rpbcd.org/AIScontrol](http://rpbcd.org/AIScontrol)

After treatment, the MnDNR recommends not using the water for these activities for these number of days:

 **Swimming**  
1 day

 **Drinking**  
3 days

 **Irrigation**  
5 days
